

## **COVID-19 Guidelines**\*

Both PCR and Rapid Test will be accepted.

According to the CDC<sup>1</sup>, fully vaccinated is defined as two weeks following either series of Pfizer/Moderna or single J&J COVID-19 vaccine.

A return to work/school is the final decision of the TLC HR and/or Nursing Office.

### **SYMPTOMATIC:**

If you have one or more of these symptoms:

- Fever (100.0 F or higher)/ Chills
- Difficulty breathing/shortness of breath
- Loss of taste or smell
- Muscle/body aches
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Headache
- Fatique
- Nasal congestion or runny nose

#### You may not return to work/ school until you are:

- Fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication;
- Have improved symptoms;
- Receive a negative test; OR
- Return to work/school on Day 6 if asymptomatic.

You may also be asked to submit a medical diagnosis.

## **IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT:**

#### AT SCHOOL:

# **Exempt from Testing and Quarantine:**

- Asymptomatic and fully vaccinated;
- Classroom close contacts if both individuals were masked and more than 3 feet apart;
- Bus close contacts masks on, windows open;
- Have had COVID within the past 90 days and are asymptomatic.

#### **Must Quarantine:**

If you are unvaccinated OR symptomatic, you <u>may not</u> return to work/school until you:

- · Quarantine for five days;
- May return on Day 6 if asymptomatic, and;
- Continue to wear a mask until Day 10 and monitor for symptoms.

#### **OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL:**

You have been within 6-feet of a COVID-19 positive individual while indoors, for at least 15 minutes during a 24-hour period.

#### **Exempt from Quarantine:**

- Asymptomatic and fully vaccinated:
- Have had COVID within the past 90 days and asymptomatic.

#### **Must Quarantine:**

If you are unvaccinated OR symptomatic, you <u>may not</u> return to work/school until you:

- Quarantine for five days;
- May return on Day 6 if asymptomatic, and;
- Continue to wear a mask until Day 10 and monitor for symptoms.

# TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19:

Isolate for minimum of 5
days, beginning from onset of symptoms OR the day the test was taken.

You may return to school/work on Day 6 as long as:

- You have no symptoms;
- You continue to wear a mask whenever you are around others;
- You have been fever-free for at least 24 hours without fever-reducing medication;
- You continue to monitor symptoms until Day 10.
