

Parent Attestation

Parents must sign written attestations regarding symptoms of COVID-19 for any household contacts with COVID-19. Parents must send in the attestation form before their child returns to campus. Your child will only be permitted to return to campus classes after the form is signed and received.

By signing this attestation, I attest that every day I send my child to school, I am confirming the following:

Today or in the past 24 hours, my child has not nor any household members have not had any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (temperature of 100.0°F or above), felt feverish, or had chills
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Difficulty breathing
- Gastrointestinal symptoms (diarrhea, nausea, vomiting)

- Fatigue
- Headache
- New loss of smell/taste
- New muscle aches
- Any other signs of illness

In the past 14 days, my child has not had close contact with a person known to be infected with the novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

In the past 14 days my child has not traveled outside of the Low Risk* States.

I have not given my child medicine to lower a fever.

Prior to coming to school, a self-screen was done at home checking for the following symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Gastrointestinal symptoms
- New loss of taste/smell

- Muscle aches, or
- Any other symptoms that feel like a cold
