**Books:** gateway to the English language; Marie Philip was known for her love of books

**Hands Waving:** sign language expression for applause and celebration



**TLC Sign Name:** The “ILY” (I Love You) hand shape in ASL is also used as the “sign name” for The Learning Center for the Deaf
